Overview of the country

Context

- From 2000 to 2010 the percentage of people living in Benin with less than 1 \$ US increased from 47.3% to 51.6%, while the MDG target is to lower it to 15% in 2015;
- Committed to reach the MDG, Benin applied and has been granted the Millennium Villages Project (MVP) to better tackle the issue of poverty with regards to the MDGs.
- The MVP seek to end extreme poverty by working with the poorest of the poor;
- The MVP aim to helping people lift themselves out of extreme poverty and to achieving the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) within 5 years.

Description

- The MVP is a 7 million USD project jointly financed by the Goverenment of Japan and the Government of Benin, aiming to demonstrate how the MDGs can be achieved in the poorest communities through a results-based, monitored and measured interventions at the village and district level;
- The MVP is placed under the institutional authority of the Ministry of Development and Economic Analysis and the leading authority of the UNDP-Benin;
- The project include the development of areas like agriculture, health, education, water and sanitation, community development infrastructures, gender and M&E.

Description (cont.)

- The project will benefit from all the stakeholders of the community like individuals, enterprises, charities, local communities and other projects' past experiences.
- A the beginning (2011), « Founougo and Kanderou » are the villages in which, the project is being implemented. These villages belongs to the district of Banikoara, identified as the poorest according to the data of INSAE;
- From this experience, the project will thereafter be replicated in 11 other villages and later to all the villages.

Advantages of the MVP

- Promote the administrative data sources for monitoring the MDGs at the district and village level;
- Make the MDGs monitoring indicators available at the district and village level;
- Facilitate the monitoring and reporting of the MDGs at the district and village level; Indeed, it will be easier to report the MDG at the district level if the village-level reports are available.

Challenges

- Late and incomplete recruitment of the project's management team (M&E specialist and 2 other experts not recruited yet);
- Project Office not ready (lack of equipements, electricity and high speed internet connexion)
- Difficulties to meet the administrative procedures regarding the using of petrol coupon or check in rural areas;
- Make the villagers adhere to the project, and contribute to the achieving of the targeted goals.

Upcoming

- Complete the recruitment of the project management team;
- Build fishing and livestock farming facilities;
- Build classrooms and school canteens;
- Empower the village women;
- Repair and equip health centers;
- Finalise the baseline study of the project;
- Replicate the project to 11 other villages;
- Etc.

Recommendations

- Make sure that the project addresses the villagers needs, in order to benefit from their cooperation;
- Develop a Monitoring&Evaluation workplan with a definition of key outcomes indicators able to mesure the progress towards the achieving of the MDGs at the village level;
- Sensitise the community and its leaders to adhere to the project so as to make it successful;
- Benefit from the project to promote Civil and Vital Statistics data collection at the village level.
