Theme: “political, economic, social, cultural and environmental transformations as a means of advancing the care society and gender equality”.

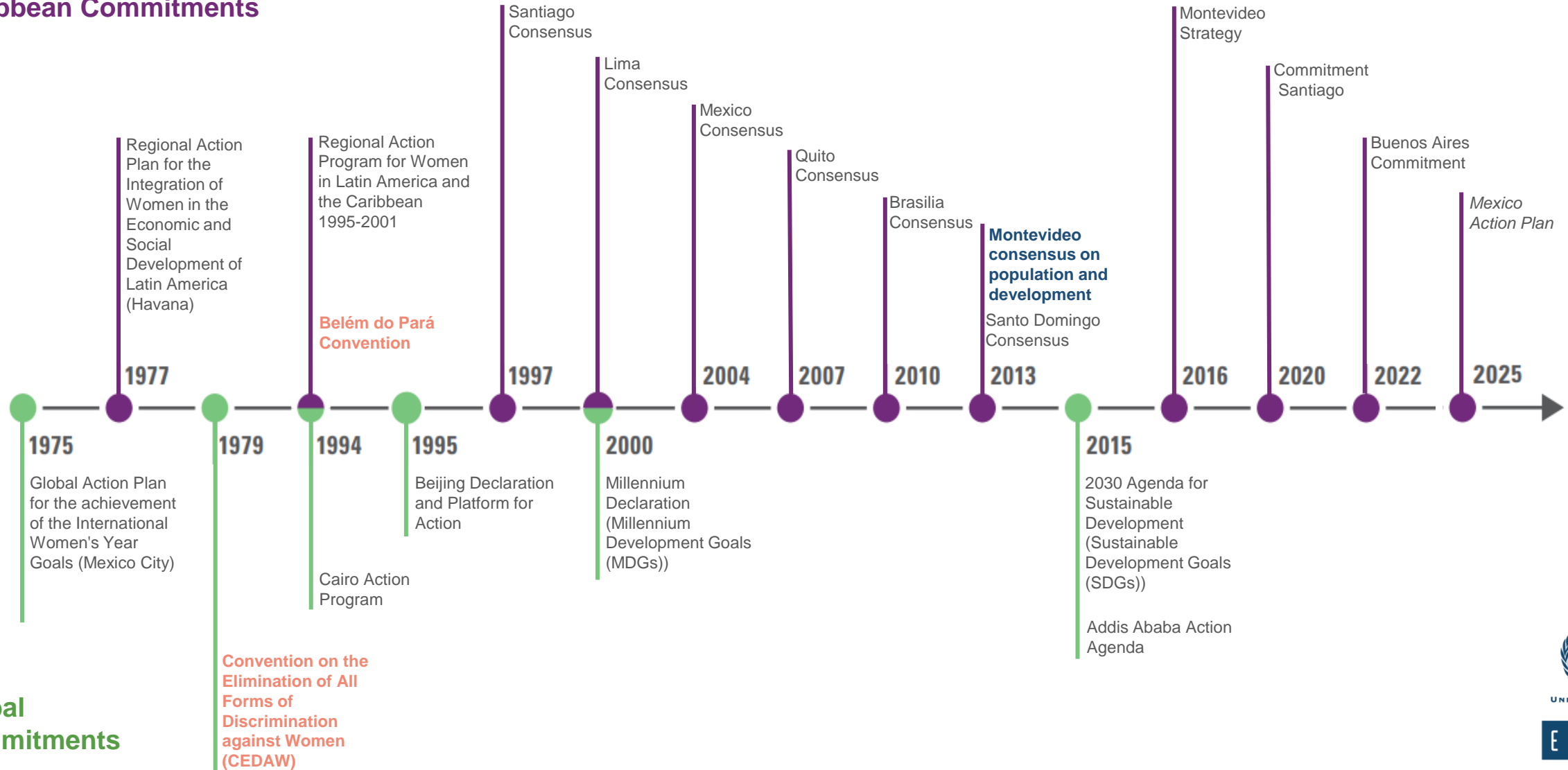
Context: thirty years after the adoption of the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action at the Fourth World Conference on Women, held in Beijing in 1995, and fifty years after the First World Conference on Women, which was held in Mexico City in 1975.

Road map: includes regional and sub-regional activities with governments, agencies, funds and programs from the United Nations system, intergovernmental organizations, academics, parliamentarians and civil society organizations, among other actors.

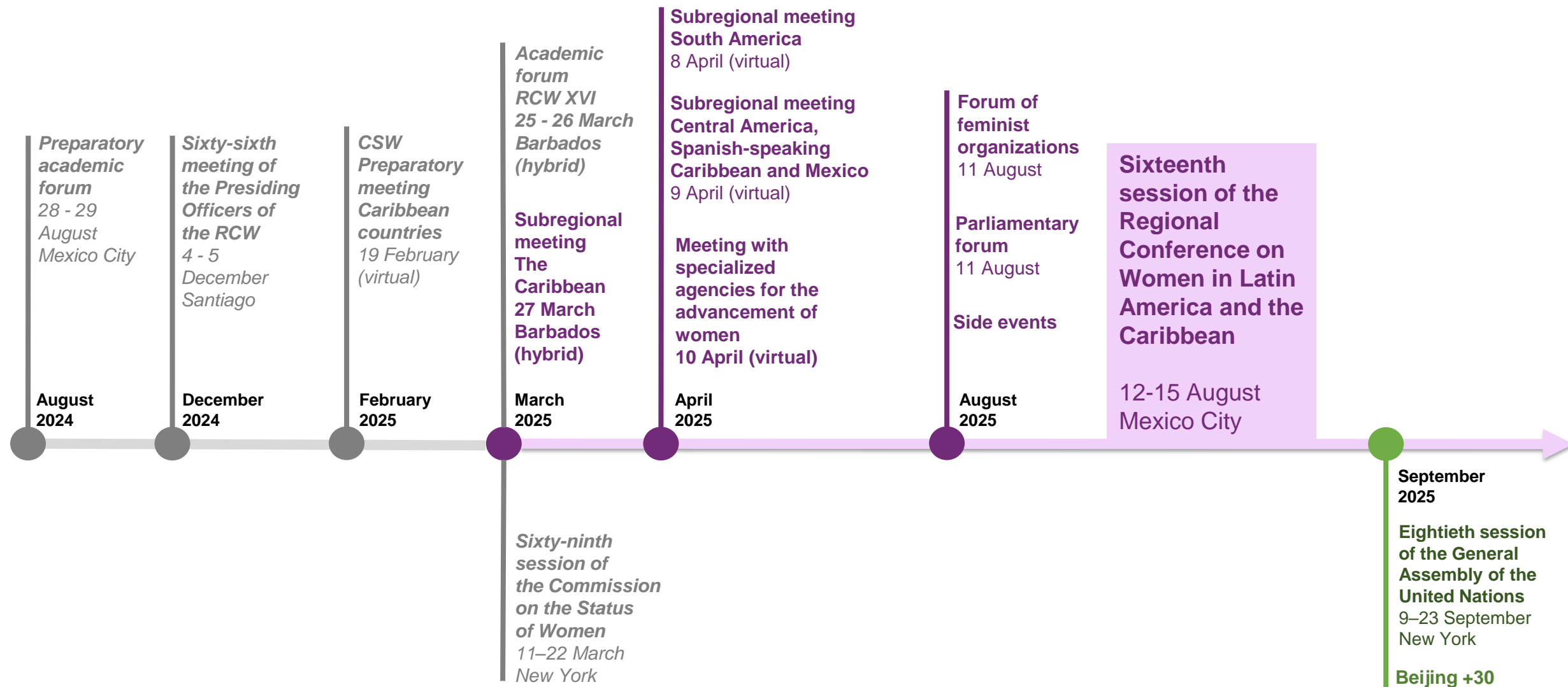
