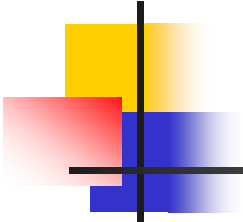

Antecedentes (1)

- 1991: Los países europeos identifican actividades solapadas entre la Comisión Económica para Europa (UN-ECE), OCDE y Eurostat. Se inicia una discusión sobre una posible cooperación.
- Reunión para hacer una revisión conjunta de los programas : reunión conjunta de las 3 organizaciones para estudiar el solapamiento del trabajo, de los programas y de las reuniones.
- 1993: Se inicia la **Presentación Integrada de Actividades Estadísticas**. Las 3 organizaciones hacen una puesta en común de sus programas de trabajo, reuniones y actividades para los próximos 2 años (según formato UNECE).
- Se extiende a otras organizaciones que son activas en Europa (FMI, BM, UNSD etc.)

Antecedentes (2)

Al cabo de algunos años...

2003: Se elimina este sistema descriptivo por ser demasiado complejo tratándose de 55 países (ECE). Se pasa a un sistema basado en una red (DISA/IP)

Welcome to DISA

Compendium of statistical work programmes of international organizations active in Europe, North America and Central Asia from 2003 to 2007

DISA started, in 1993, as an Integrated Presentation of the work of the three biggest international statistical agencies in Europe: Eurostat, UNECE and OECD. In 2004 the Integrated Presentation was converted to the Database of International Statistical Activities (DISA) DISA is mainly forward looking, concentrating on future work rather than past achievements. It is a very useful reference tool - a coherent catalogue of almost all planned work in international statistics.

50 statistical areas
The DISA is unique in that the work programmes are brought together and presented under about 50 headings and is in a format that enables the goals and planned activities to be monitored and coordinated. When you select "by statistical domain/area" from the left side menu, you will get a list of 5 statistical domains further divide into 50 areas. You can select any of them and have a look which international organizations are active in the area of your interest, what they do, and what international events are planned in that particular area.



More than 25 international organizations
and a number of city groups, intersecretariat working groups and task forces participate in this coordinating effort. They present their annual work programmes. When you click on "by organization" on the left side menu, you will be able to find activities of a particular organization.

Business Tendency and Consumer Opinion Surveys

Purpose
To collect and disseminate business tendency and consumer opinion survey data for OECD Member countries and selected non-Member economies. To promote wider use of business tendency and consumer opinion surveys in OECD Member countries and selected non-Member economies. To develop international statistical standards and to encourage scientific research in this field of statistics.

Objectives and outputs
This activity involves the ongoing collection and publication of an extensive range of business tendency and consumer opinion survey data and related metadata from OECD Member countries and large emerging NMEs + Indonesia. The survey data are published in the OECD's monthly Main Economic Indicators (MEI). Data collection is co-ordinated with the European Commission, with the OECD taking primary responsibility for data collection from national sources only for non-EU OECD Member countries and the large emerging NMEs + Indonesia. During the year further work was undertaken on the portal which has been developed to provide a focus / hub for information relating to business tendency and consumer opinion surveys. The website includes links to existing international guidelines and recommendations, questionnaires used by national institutes, summary metadata describing key elements of national surveys, selected country data, selected best practice, key terminology.

Main Developments for 2007

General aspects:
Implementation of the work plan arising out of the joint European Commission OECD workshop on business tendency and consumer opinion surveys and composite indicators held in Brussels in November 2005 and the OECD BTS / COS Workshop held in Rome in September 2006. Considerable effort was made to improve the methodological transparency of survey data through the inclusion of additional metadata in MetaStore. The plan entails developments in a number of specific areas, namely: the evolution of standards to promote greater harmonisation of outputs produced by different countries; development of standards for the presentation of metadata resulting in greater transparency; procedures for improving response rates; expansion of survey coverage into the service sector; etc. Work in 2007 will entail continued collection and dissemination of metadata from non-EU and BRICS + Indonesian national institutes which will complement similar methodological information collected by the European Commission for EU countries. Publication of non-seasonally adjusted series. The development of normalised business and consumer confidence indicators and regional/zone aggregates for sectors outside manufacturing will be continued in 2007.

Situación actual (3)

DISA/IP Base de datos de actividades estadísticas internacionales (programa integrado)

La preparación del Programa Integrado se hace en dos fases:

- 1) Las organizaciones internacionales (25) presentan sus programas a la Secretaría de ECE que se encarga de ensamblarlos durante el mes de enero
- 2) Revisión detallada del Programa Integrado por el Bureau de la Conferencia de Estadísticos Europeos con el fin de identificar solapamientos y evitar duplicaciones del trabajo.

Requisitos

- Identificar un número limitado de organizaciones que cubran la mayor parte de la región (BID, FMI, BM, Secretaría de CEPAL...)

- Elegir un coordinador (CEPAL)
- Empezar identificando los solapamientos que se producen a nivel de actividades y reuniones para ir ampliándolo en fases posteriores
