


















#### **NATIONAL GEOSPATIAL DATA POLICY**



The National Geospatial Data Policy has been formulated to respond to the needs of the population in terms of efficient access to territorial data and information.


It is aligned with the **UN-IGIF** and **UN-GSGF** frameworks, and represents a roadmap towards efficient, inclusive and sustainable information management.
