## WHAT HAVE WE DONE


- Consultant hired with support of ECLAC to conduct preliminary stakeholder

## WHAT HAVE WE DONE

- Country work plan developed consultation with the UN and UN ECLAC
- Consultant selected and engaged to support Dominica's 1<sup>st</sup> VNR
- Inception meeting held with Consultant and work commenced on the country work plan.
- National Committee convened and has been meeting weekly

- TORs reviewed with National Committee and tasks assigned to collect and submit data on SDG indicators
- Cabinet Note submitted on the VNR.
- Survey to collect data electronically rolled out
- Framework for the report developed and is being reviewed
