



## **OBJECTIVES**

- Strengthen the capacity of NSOs to produce harmonized household survey data sets;
- Improve electronic accessibility of systematized household micro level data sets via the Internet.

## CHALLENGES

- Reluctance of Member States to share micro-data;
- Unavailability of technical expertise to assist with data preparation for online system.
