

- between **2016 and 2024**, **32 LAC** countries submitted VNRs to the HLPF in New York, including **20 countries** that submitted **more than once**.
- The 65 VNRs submitted by LAC countries provide a wealth of information, analysis, processes, good practices and lessons learned on the road to 2030.
- Of the 39 countries that will submit a
   VNR in 2025, 6 are from Latin America
   and the Caribbean: Bahamas (3),
   Dominican Republic (3), El Salvador
   (3), Guatemala (4), Saint Lucia (2) and
   Suriname (2).

## **ECLAC's Community of Practice on** the Voluntary National Reviews









- Informal mechanism for exchanging best practices and lessons learned between countries tasked with monitoring and coordinating the implementation of the 2030 Agenda and the process of elaborating the VNRs.
- It includes government officials, professionals, researchers and technical experts, as well as representatives of ECLAC and the rest of the United Nations system, including the Resident Coordinator Offices. Occasionally representatives of youth, civil society, private sector, academia, local authorities, parliamentarians and other stakeholders are invited.
- Monthly informal discussions between peers at the technical level with interpretation between English, Spanish, French and Portuguese to share good practices, challenges and lessons learned in the preparation of the VNRs.

## The Eighth Meeting of the Forum of the Countries of Latin America and the Caribbean on Sustainable Development

WHAT? The main intergovernmental, multistakeholder platform for follow-up & review of the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development at the regional level.

WHO? Representatives from governments of ECLAC's member States, associate members and subsidiary bodies, civil society, academia, private sector, development banks, UN Resident Coordinators and other UN entities, regional and subregional integration blocs.

**WHEN? 31 March - 3 April 2025** 

**WHERE?** Santiago de Chile, ECLAC



#### **Outlook HLPF 2025**

- The HLPF 2025 will take place from 14 to 24 July 2025 on the theme "Advancing sustainable, inclusive, science- and evidence-based solutions for the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and its Sustainable Development Goals for leaving no one behind."
- It will conduct in-depth reviews of **SDG 3** (good health and well-being), **SDG 5** (gender equality), **SDG 8** (decent work and economic growth), **SDG 14** (life below water) and **SDG 17** (partnerships for the goals).
- The 2025 HLPF will support the implementation of the **political declaration** and other outcomes of the **SDG Summit 2023** as well as the **Pact for the Future** adopted at the **Summit of the Future** for advancing the 2030 Agenda and the SDGs until their deadline in 2030.
- A total of 39 countries will present their VNRs at the HLPF 2025 in New York, with six countries from the region of Latin America and the Caribbean, namely Bahamas, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Guatemala, Saint Lucia and Suriname.
- As every year, other events, including Side Events, VNR Labs, Special Events, and Exhibitions, will be organized on the margins of the 2025 HLPF.



### **Outlook SDG Summit 2027**

- The theme of the 2026 HLPF will be "Transformative, equitable, innovative and coordinated actions for the 2030 Agenda and its SDGs for a sustainable future for all". The Goals to undergo in-depth review are SDGs 6 (clean water and sanitation), 7 (affordable and clean energy), 9 (industry, innovation and infrastructure), 11 (sustainable cities and communities), and 17 (partnerships for the goals).
- The theme of the 2027 HLPF will be: "Scaling up just transitions to achieving sustainable development, poverty eradication and the full implementation of the 2030 Agenda and its SDGs". The Goals to be reviewed in depth are SDGs 4 (quality education), 10 (reduced inequalities), 12 (responsible consumption and production), 15 (life on land) and 17 (partnerships for the goals).
- The General Assembly will convene the next SDG Summit in September 2027.
