



"Our mission is to maximize healthcare services of the OECS countries by pooled procurement and management of pharmaceuticals and related medical supplies."






## OECS/PPS VISION STATEMENT

#### **Background**

- Access to essential medicines is a basic human right.
- Medicines are a major requirement for foreign exchange.
- Financial constraints have rendered it difficult for OECS Governments to adequately finance medicines



#### **Features**

- Established in 1986
- Permanent Secretariat
- OECS Economic Union
- Country-based committees
- Payments through Central Bank
- Self-financing in 1989 with 11% surcharge
- Shared culture, language, ethnicity, currency
- Restricted International bid for 840 items with 50 suppliers


#### Benefits of pooled procurement

- Economies of scale, ↓ prices,20%
- Monopsony, ↑ bargaining power
- Fixed, common price for tender period

#### Non- economic, value-added


- Enhanced quality assurance
