




### Number of reports and countries having presented at least once, 2016-2022

  - VNR presentations from <u>12 to 15 July</u>
- **Theme:** "Building back better from the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) while advancing the full implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development"
- SDGs under review this year:\*
  - **SDG 4** (quality education)
  - SDG 5 (gender equality)
  - SDG 14 (life below water)
  - SDG 15 (life on land)
  - SDG 17 (partnerships for the Goals

#### \*VNR reports should cover ALL 17 SDGs $\textcircled{\odot}$

**Format for the VNR presentation:** Anticipated to be in-person with hybrid component (to be confirmed in May)

#### **Timing of VNR Presentations at the HLPF:**

1<sup>st</sup> time VNR: (*30* mins at the HLPF):
10 minutes for presentation
20 minutes for Q&A

2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> time VNR: (25 mins at the HLPF)
 10 minutes for presentation
 15 minutes for Q&A

#### Format:

**The panel format**: presentations are held sequentially; when all the countries participating in the session have presented, questions are asked of the presenting countries. **The individual format**: a country makes its presentation, followed by questions.

#### **Tips and Good Practices for VNR Reports:**

- Reporting on all 17 SDGs
- Showcasing interlinkages and trade-offs
- Showcasing synergies
- Incorporation into national policies, strategies and frameworks
- Addressing systemic issues and showcasing impact
- Highlight progress made since the previous presentation
- Impact and measures related to COVID-19
- Addressing leaving no behind
- Identify relevant actions to accelerate progress towards the 2030 Agenda
- Consider how the previous VNRs' conclusions can be fed back into policy improvement

#### CONSIDERATIONS FOR:

### **VNR Reports and Presentations**

#### **Tips and Good Practices for VNR Presentations:**

- Well thought out structure to VNR presentation
- Include various stakeholders: civil society, academia, business and industry/ private sector, parliamentarians, youth, women, local authorities, marginalized groups, etc
- Showcase progress since previous VNR
- Clear narrative of national SDG implementation
- Showcase achievements in SDG monitoring
- Show achievements and challenges
- Showcase VNR preparations
- Highlight key programmes, initiatives and progress on SDGs
- Showcase the impact of policies
- COVID-19 response and measures
- Use engaging audiovisuals and data visualization
- Use as a platform for partnerships
