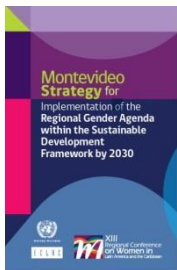

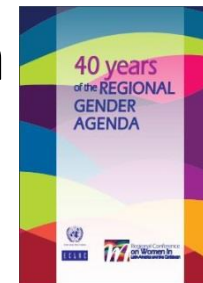


- 2 In each of the sessions of the Regional Conference, a follow-up report about implementation of Montevideo Strategy will be made.

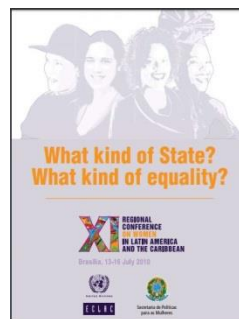
