PRIORITY AREAS

- Sustained and sustainable, inclusive and equitable economic growth with decent work for all
- Sustainable energy
- Disaster risk reduction
- Oceans and seas
- Food security and nutrition
- Water and sanitation
- Sustainable transportation
- Sustainable consumption and production
- Management of chemicals and waste, including hazardous waste
- Health and non-communicable diseases
- Gender equality and women's empowerment
- Social development

- Invasive alien species



Enabling Framework

- Central to the measurement & reporting of these goals and targets:
 - Goals and targets must be measurable
 - Clear metadata, methodology etc. for each indicator
 - Flexible and dynamic national statistical system
 - Quality data relevant, accurate, timely, coherent, assessable
 - Well outlined monitoring and evaluation mechanisms
 - Clear reporting channels



Process of Selecting a Minimum Core

- Tier 1- These indicators are conceptually clear, with established methodology and standards available and data are regularly produced by countries.
- Tier 2- These indicators are conceptually clear, with established methodology and standards available but data are not regularly produced by countries.
- Tier 3- There are no established methodology and standards, or methodology/standards were being developed/tested for these indicators.



Criteria for Selecting as part of Minimum Core

- Was it a national priority?
- Was it an indicator in the SAMOA Pathway?
- Was it included in the CMDGs?

The question of whether or not the data was currently available in the national statistical system was not a deciding factor.
