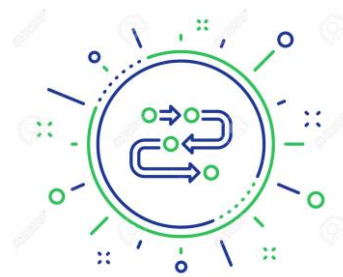

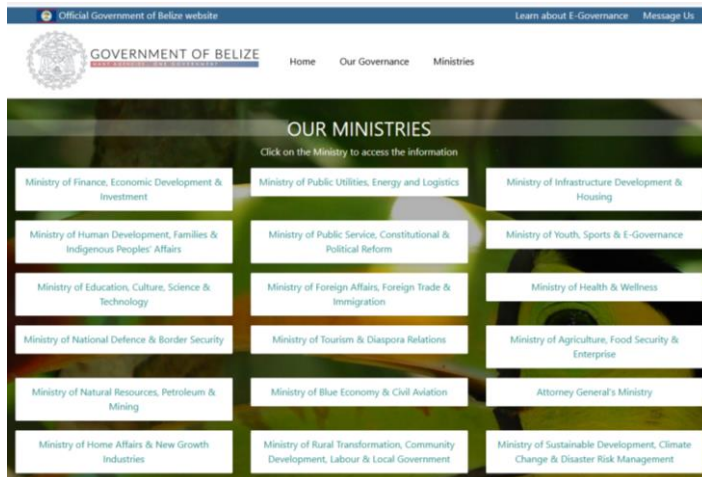

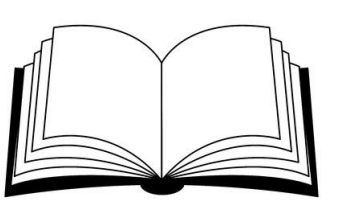

Consultation Phase

1. **Series of consultation** were held by members of the Technical Team – PPU & SDU
2. Involved the **PPU/SDU team visiting** line Ministries and engaging them in a guided discussion so as to elicit information necessary for elaborating the Strategy.
3. **Line Ministries** - CEOs and their Ministry's experts, senior officials, and Heads of Department and Statutory Bodies.
4. **Non-government Stakeholders** – Heads of the organization, institution, agency (Executive Director, Chairman, President, Leader of the Opposition etc.)
5. Meeting started **face-to-face**, however, given Covid-19 pandemic we had to switch to virtual meetings.

Consultation Phase

1. Meetings were conducted during an **8-week period** - August 24 – October 15
2. A total of **35 meetings** were carried - **22 Line Ministries & 13 Non-government**
