

NTA – National Training Agency: Coordinate, facilitate and enable the growth, development and quality assurance of TVET in Jamaica.























Critical Interventions

• Increased Partnerships and Collaborations

- Expanded Institutional Framework Performance-based funding
- Student financial support mechanisms including the provision of loans, stipends and grants
- Targeted funding for underserved persons including those with special needs


PLAR

Funding Mechanism – Providing financial assistance through grant funding for capacity expansion or modernization and new start-ups.


Human Capacity Development – Provision of onthe-job training and certification (Apprenticeship and Job Certification)


