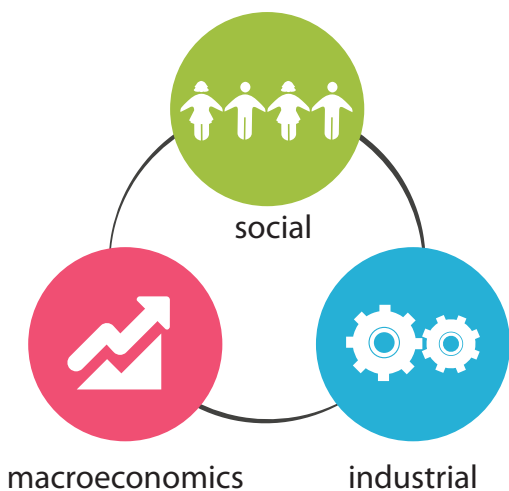
PERU 2014
