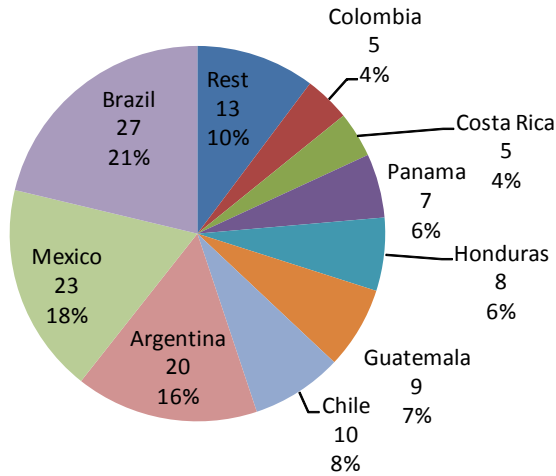


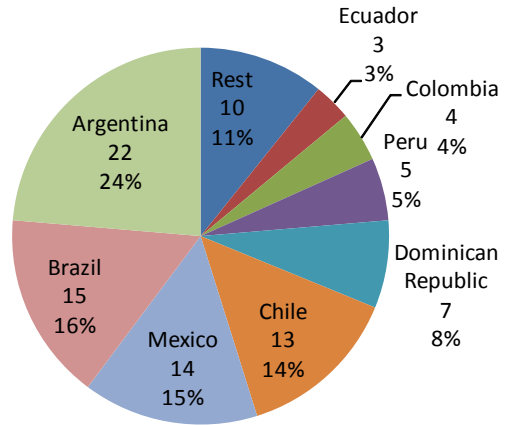
LATIN AMERICA AND THE CARIBBEAN: BREAKDOWN OF WTO DISPUTES BY COUNTRY, 1995-2014
