With which tools?

National Policy for Risk Reduction

Order the system according to the different emergency levels and phases of the disaster cycle.

Implementing clear disaster management governance

Establishes the National Disaster Prevention and Response System. The National emergency office is replaced with the national disaster prevention and response service.

Creates Disaster Risk Management Committees at national, regional and communal levels, in charge of disaster management governance.

The case of hurricanes in Turks and Caicos Islands

Those affected by hurricanes must request reparation for the damages caused by hurricanes. The State decides based on each chase which repair to be provided.

> To the legal owners of property affected by hurricanes, the State may request a payment of up to 10% of the repair, if granted.
