## DESCRIPTION OF REQUIREMENTS

### \*\*\*English Version\*\*\*

This is a Request for Expression of Interest for a solicitation process that will follow and not the actual solicitation. Exact requirements will be in the solicitation document which will be shared with the parties expressing their interest.

The United Nations Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean (ECLAC) and the United Nations System in Chile are seeking companies with local representation in Chile, with appropriate experience and technical and financial capacity to participate in the bidding process for the following services:

- 1) Dismantling of existing elevators
- 2) Supply and installation of elevators

The process is valid for the building that houses the offices of FAO and UNDP, located at 3241 Dag Hammarskjöld Street, Vitacura District.

The existing elevator system has 6 levels and 2 cabins. To be replaced by a 7-level, 2-cabin elevator.

Esta es una solicitud de expresión de interés para un proceso de licitación que se publicará y no de una licitación propiamente. Los requisitos exactos figurarán en el pliego de condiciones, que se comunicará a las partes que manifiesten su interés.

La Comisión Económica para América Latina y el Caribe de las Naciones Unidas (CEPAL) y el Sistema de Naciones Unidas en Chile, buscan empresas con representación local en Chile, debidamente experimentadas y con capacidad técnica y financiera para participar en el proceso de licitación de los siguientes servicios:

- 1) Desmontaje Ascensores existentes
- 2) Suministro e instalación de Ascensores

El proceso es válido para el Edificio que alberga las oficinas de FAO y PNUD, ubicados en la Calle Dag Hammarskjöld 3241, Comuna de Vitacura.

El sistema de ascensores existente es de 6 niveles y 2 cabinas. Para ser reemplazado por uno de 7 niveles y 2 cabinas.



## SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS / INFORMATION (IF ANY)

Description of Activities:

1) Dismantling of existing elevators:

The dismantling of the entire existing elevator system is requested (cabins, doors, machine room, rail system, guides and counterweights) as appropriate and their disposal in an authorized landfill.

2) Supply and installation of elevators:

The supply of all necessary parts, import, and internment of the complete elevator system is requested. In addition, its correct installation according to the manufacturer's specifications and current regulations.

In this Expression of Interest stage, ECLAC will evaluate those specialist and construction companies that have at least 8 years of experience and that are capable of carrying out the works, specifically in the installation and assembly of this type of works.

The general coordination of the projects will be in charge of the Facilities Management Unit of ECLAC until the generation of the service contract and then directly supervised by FAO-UNDP.

Descripción de Actividades:

1) Desmontaje Ascensores existentes:

Se solicita el desmontaje de todo el sistema de ascensores existentes (cabinas, puertas, sala de máquinas, sistema de rieles, guías y contrapesos) según correspondan y su eliminación en botadero autorizado.

2) Suministro e instalación de Ascensores:

Se consulta por el suministro de todas las partes necesarias, importación, internación del sistema completo de ascensores. Además, su correcta instalación según especificaciones del fabricante y la normativa vigente.

En esta etapa de Expresión de Interés, la CEPAL evaluará a aquellas empresas especialistas y constructoras que tengan al menos 8 años de experiencia y que sean capaces de ejecutar los trabajos de obras, específicamente en la instalación y montaje de este tipo de obras.

La coordinación general de los proyectos estará a cargo de Facilities Management Unit de la CEPAL hasta la generación del contrato de servicios y luego supervisada directamente por FAO-PNUD.

## EOI INSTRUCTIONS

### 1) Registering as a Vendor with the United Nations

Vendors interested in fulfilling the requirement described above must be registered at the UN Global Marketplace ([www.ungm.org](http://www.ungm.org)) with the UN Secretariat in order to be eligible to participate in any solicitation. Information on the registration process can be found at <https://www.un.org/Depts/ptd/vendors>.

#### **Prerequisites for Eligibility**

In order to be eligible for UN registration, you must declare that:

- A. Your company (as well as any parent, subsidiary or affiliate companies) is not listed in, or associated with a company or individual listed in:
  - I. the Compendium of United Nations Security Council Sanctions Lists (<https://www.un.org/securitycouncil/content/un-sc-consolidated-list>), or
  - II. the IIC Oil for Food List website or, if listed on either, this has been disclosed to the United Nations Procurement Division in writing.
- B. Your company (as well as any parent, subsidiary or affiliate companies) is not currently removed or suspended by the United Nations or any other UN organisation (including the World Bank);
- C. Your company (as well as any parent, subsidiary or affiliate companies) is not under formal investigation, nor have been sanctioned within the preceding three (3) years, by any national authority of a United Nations Member State for engaging or having engaged in proscribed practices, including but not limited to: corruption, fraud, coercion, collusion, obstruction, or any other unethical practice;
- D. Your company has not declared bankruptcy, are not involved in bankruptcy or receivership proceedings, and there is no judgment or pending legal action against your company that could impair your company's operations in the foreseeable future;
- E. Your company does not employ, or anticipate employing, any person(s) who is, or has been a UN staff member within the last year, if said UN staff member has or had prior professional dealings with the Vendor in his/her capacity as UN staff member within the last three years of service with the UN (in accordance with UN post-employment restrictions published in ST/SGB/2006/15).
- F. Your company undertakes not to engage in proscribed practices (including but not limited to: corruption, fraud, coercion, collusion, obstruction, or any other unethical practice), with the UN or any other party, and to conduct business in a manner that averts any financial, operational, reputational or other undue risk to the UN.
