## Role of the Statistics Department

Mission: Enlightening, Empowering, and Enriching Lives through Statistics

Global Objective: To make available statistical information for planning and policy making

Legislation: Statistics Act Chapter 23.31 of 2002

## **Duties of Statistics Department**

(a) to collect, compile, analyse, abstract and publish statistical information relative to the commercial, industrial, social, economic and general activities and conditions of the people who are the inhabitants of this State;

(b) to collaborate with all other departments of Government and with local authorities in the collection, computation and publication of statistical records of administration;

(c) to take any census in the State;

(d) generally to organize a co-ordinated scheme of social and economic statistics and intelligence pertaining to the State.

Types of Official Statistics Business and Economic: Gross Domestic Product (GDP), Consumer Price Index (CPI), External Sector Statistics, Government Statistics, Merchandise Trade Statistics, Tourism Statistics, and Production Statistics.

Social and Demographic: Statistics on Health/Medical, Education, and Crime.

Special Surveys: Standard of Living Survey, Labour Force Survey, Awareness Surveys (Knowledge of the OECS, Youth Issues, Health and Wellness, and Environmental Awareness), Population and Housing Census and Agricultural Census.

## Strengths of the data sources used

- Existence of good collaborative relationship between the Statistics Department and other Ministries, Departments and Agencies of Government
- Availability of data whether in the form of stored records or published statistics
- Increased used of technology in the compilation of data across government ministries, departments and other agencies

## Weaknesses of the data sources used

- Significant amount of data is still held in the form of administrative records and stored in paper format
- Administrative and clerical staff responsible for data entry are often insufficiently trained in statistical methods
- Publication of data in such forms in word processing and incompatible data reporting formats
- <sup>o</sup> Timeliness of reporting
- Need for updated computer systems and software application to process data
