**"In April 2018** during its seventy-fourth session, the **United Nations General Assembly** approved 12 voluntary global performance **targets for** <u>road safety</u> risk factors and **"encouraged Member States to take steps**, towards achieving those targets. At the same time, the General Assembly also requested the United Nations system, to support Member States to help them achieve global targets. And also <u>invited all relevant stakeholders</u>, international organizations, development banks and funding agencies, foundations, professional associations <u>and private sector companies</u> to scale up funding in support of road safety". ## **Road Safety**

## A proven methodology for finding ways to improve road safety

- 1. Database creation by collecting data from all available sources
- 2. Road crashes data analysis and data dashboard creation
- 3. Goals setting together with road safety agents
- 4. Critical areas and profiles identification (road black spots *heat map*)
- 5. Action plan establishment and execution
- 6. Implementation of *road safety management system* and results control routine



## We are sharing our knowledge and measuring impact

Location	Outcome in pilot areas
Sao Paulo State, Brasilia, Brazil	16% reduction in fatalities
Shanghai, China	90% reduction in fatalities in deadly cross-roads
Atlanta, USA	26% reduction in crashes
Umlazi, South Africa	23% reduction in fatalities
