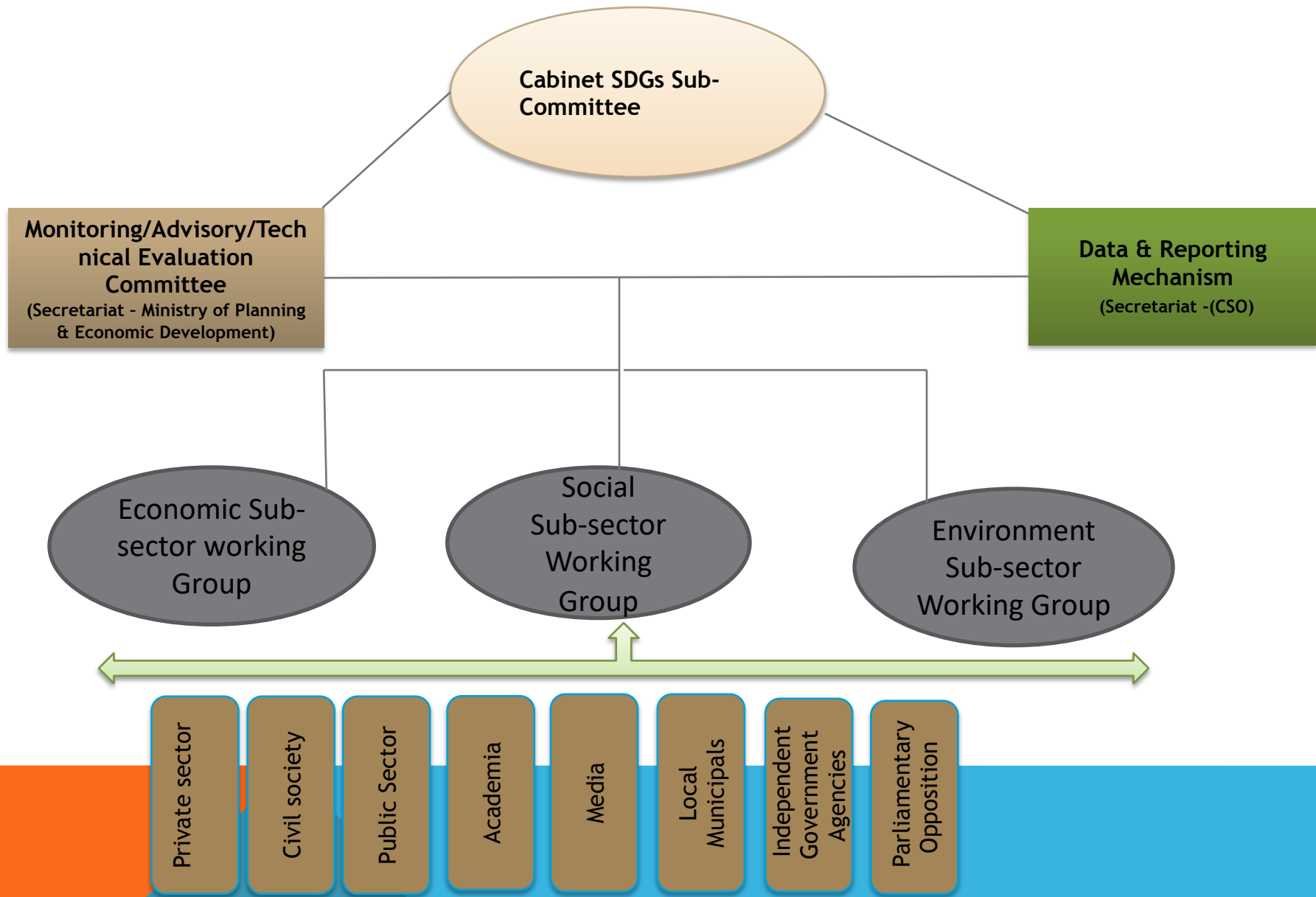
DELAYS IN IMPLEMENTING THE SDGS AT THE NATIONAL LEVEL

- ❑ Effects of recent disasters and changes in policy directions/national priorities;
- ❑ Absence of a clear and strategic national sustainable development framework with multi-sector priority focused areas;
- ❑ Domestic financing and/or mobilization of resources for a broad range of issues;
- ❑ Ownership of the strategic process – Who leads? Planning or Stats
- ❑ Limited efforts to build awareness given no formal operating secretariat or staff with formal mandates
- ❑ Data and reporting challenges;
- ❑ Limited knowledge of existing adaptable monitoring and evaluation framework;


EFFORTS TO STRENGTHEN INSTITUTIONAL MECHANISMS (STRUCTURES, PROCESSES, MANAGEMENT TOOLS)

- a) Interim arrangement lead by CSO in early part of 2018;
- a) Proposed institutional mechanisms for SDG implementation by Planning and CSO (as illustrated on next slide);
- c) Validation of model through assessment to determine human resources capacity of the Ministry of Planning to follow through on all mandates;






ONGOING M&E ACTIVITIES:

- ❑ The NRDS indicator monitoring framework to be validated by CoPS;
 - ❑ Newly developed 'Submission Procedures' for EaSR with a focus on evaluations a through gender-responsive; poverty-reduction; equity promotion lens, etc.
 - ❑ Effective screening of programs and projects through SITS framework
 - ❑ Commitment for Results and online reporting tool;
 - ❑ Cabinet endorsed reporting compliance agreement;
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ONGOING M&E ACTIVITIES CON'T

- ☐ Technological upgrade and use of Computer Aided Personal Interview (CAPI) system for quick collection and analysis of survey data;
 - ☐ New Public Sector Investment Programme (PSIP) Investment Proposals Form and Guidance Document for the Development of Project Proposal Submissions
 - ☐ Assist line ministries in developing ministry level M&E systems
 - ☐ Developed guidelines on PSIP implementation modalities for effective results for consideration by ministries as part of strategic planning process;
 - ☐ Utilize existing PSIP meetings as a feedback and coaching mechanism; particularly for low performers
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NEXT STEPS

- ❑ Improve data management tools
 - Design an SDG M&E framework using existing tools;
 - Determine SDG M&E budget needs

- ❑ Build capacity through activities:
 - Institutional assessment of national statistical system
 - National level knowledge sharing and learning trainings/workshop/seminars to change mindsets, including utilization of M&E and preparation of VNRs

- ❑ Share insights from M&E with data collectors
