# Private Education Survey

---

The objective of the survey is to **collect information** related to ***education services*** provided to  
Cycle 2021

# Private Education Survey

---

On the region there are two modalities for this service:

1. Academic year that start and ending in **the same calendar year, T**
2. Academic year that **start at mid of T-1 and it end in t**, for example, start on September 2020 and ending in July 2021

# Private Education Survey

---

This survey collects **ONLY** information for Private Education. This means that the school **is not financed** by governments, partial or fully.

# Private Education Survey

---

In the case of educational establishments that grant scholarships, information is collected on the **annuity actually paid** by all students who do not obtain a scholarship.

# Private Education Survey

There are in total **7 items to be priced**: 5 for primary, secondary and tertiary levels and 2 for other educational programs (language course, private lessons of mathematics)

# Primary, secondary and tertiary levels

---

The information to be collect (annuity) will be the enrollment fee (tuition) plus the monthly values paid for that educational service for the entire academic year.

The tuition do not should include any cost of educational materials and support of educational services

# Primary, secondary and tertiary levels

---

***Annuity = The enrollment fee +  
monthly values paid for that  
educational service for the entire  
academic year***

# Secondary level

---

For Upper Secondary there are 2 kinds of educational establishment: Secondary High and Secondary technical High. The information to be collect is **Secondary High**.

If in your country the **Secondary technical high is important** in the educative cycle, **we can include a new product** for differentiate this kind of educational establishment

# Secondary level

---

**Bilingual schools** if they are representative of the private sector **may be considered**, if so, add a note.

# Tertiary level

---

The collection priced for tertiary level is **ONLY** Bachelor's or equivalent level; first degree ( e.g. bachelor's, license, diploma, etc.).

Exclude programs of 5 years that grant a master's degree.

# Primary, secondary and tertiary levels

---

Is important introduce in the form information about **number of school days** in “Starting Date” and “Ending Date”

# Primary, secondary and tertiary levels

---

If all levels are provided by the same educational establishment, and there are not change in annuity, it is possible to **report the same value** at all levels

# Other educational programs

---

- For foreign language classes, **ONLY** information from establishments that provide this service, such as language **institutes or language schools**, should be collected. In this case, private lessons are excluded.
- The fee **does not should include** the cost of materials and support of educational services

# Other educational programs

---

- For the **private lesson of math's**, out of school tutoring, **the hourly rate for the services of freelancers should be collected**. The class specification corresponds to instruction for a high school senior.
- The observations for the math private lesson, corresponds to the hourly value of the educational service (chronological).
