## ECLAC activities to face the challenges in statistical work arising from the effects of the pandemic from COVID19


UN ECLAC Statistics Division has undertaken several actions to address the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on the statistical operations in Latin American and Caribbean countries.

Price collection started in 2019 for the 2020 cycle according to the proposal to split the household consumption list into 3 (1/3 in 2019, 1/3 in 2020 and 1/3 in 2021).

- A maximum of 20 countries submitted prices for Q3 2019 and a minimum of 1 country sent information for Q1 2021 to ECLAC.
- In order to use this information for the 2021 cycle, the ECLAC team is conducting a review, validation and feedback process with the countries to determine its extrapolation to the new ICP benchmark year.
