### Impact of Ageing on the Caribbean

Disparities in demographic transition

Improved general health and living conditions

Socio-economic challenges

 Opportunities for investments in social protection plans and pension schemes for working age population

## Older Persons and Development (Challenges)

 Need for intergenerational links with CBOs, FBOs and cultural groups to national bodies and institutions

- Elders under-utilized as guides & resource-persons in formal/informal settings
- Protection of human rights of elders and the creation of conditions for economic and social security

#### Older Persons and Development (Challenges)

 Need for opportunities to gain income and secure social protection

 Inequities in pensions and social welfare schemes due to gender and former employment status

• Women as de facto caregivers are disadvantaged in access to formal labor

## Older Persons and Development (Opportunities)

 Provide framework for "society for all ages" through collaboration of key stakeholders

• Enhance the role of the elderly as social & cultural mentors involving the young and old

• Create sustainable employment opportunities for older persons to secure incomes

## Older Persons and Development (Opportunities)

• Establish non-contributory pension schemes indexed to cost-of-living for informal sector

 Overcome bureaucratic hurdles to make pensions more accessible to those who are entitled

• Increase allocations in the national budget to programmes supporting the elderly

#### Advancing Health and Well-Being (Challenges)

• Impact of chronic non-communicable diseases & demand for long-term care

 More training on ageing and geriatrics for healthcare providers & family members

• Impact of migration of trained healthcare professionals on care for the elderly

#### Advancing Health and Well-Being (Challenges)

 Need to enhance community care & outreach to rural and outlying areas

 More affordable & accessible healthcare and medication for chronic diseases required

 Prevalence of HIV/AIDS among older persons on the rise

#### Advancing Health and Well-Being (Opportunities)

• Promote healthy lifestyles at all levels of society through schools & radio/TV networks

• Enhance training in geriatric care for family members, care providers & healthcare workers

• Regulatory framework by Governments to ensure quality standards of care for elderly are provided in public/private care facilities

#### Advancing Health and Well-Being (Opportunities)

• Promote the inclusion of HIV/AIDS prevention & treatment into healthcare programmes

• Improve working conditions, benefits packages & career perspectives for healthcare providers to stem migration

#### Advancing Health and Well-Being (Opportunities)

• Strengthen community healthcare services and/or utilize available mobile care facilities to facilitate elderly in remote areas

• Identify mechanisms to ensure equal access to healthcare services including special treatments/medications to poor & vulnerable older persons

### Enabling and Supportive Environments (Challenges)

 Prevention of discrimination and elder abuse in physical, psychological & cultural terms

• Grandparents burdened with additional family responsibilities due to migration

 Inclusion of the elderly in disaster preparedness and mitigation plans

### Enabling and Supportive Environments (Challenges)

Access to support needed to upgrade their accommodations

• Public spaces to provide accessibility for older persons particularly those with disabilities

• Men in older age often excluded from informal social networks in post-retirement years

### Enabling and Supportive Environments (Opportunities)

• Promote initiatives for older persons to acquire affordable property or access support

• Improve access to public buildings and affordable public transportation

• Include elderly & disabled in national and regional disaster preparedness and mitigation plans

### Enabling and Supportive Environments (Opportunities)

• Provide legislation to combat various forms of violence, abuse, neglect of the elderly

• Promote the inclusion of older persons into all aspects of social and political life in region

 Promote formation and maintenance of informal networks for elderly men and women

### Enabling and Supportive Environments (Opportunities)

- Promote the establishment of mechanisms to assist the elderly in care-taker roles, borne out of the impact of migration
- Need to streamline social policies and programmes and share best practices across the region in the context of the Caribbean Single Market & Economy
