Mandate for global reporting on the SDGs


2030 Agenda (A/Res/70/1) mandate for the Secretary-General's SDG global progress report:

Para 83. Follow-up and review at the high-level political forum will be informed by an annual progress report on the Sustainable Development Goals to be prepared by the Secretary-General in cooperation with the United Nations system, based on the global indicator framework and data produced by national statistical systems and information collected at the regional level"

In addition, the GA Resolution 70/299 states:

Para 13. "Reaffirms that the meetings of the high-level political forum will be informed by an annual progress report on the Sustainable Development Goals ..."

Summary

Pursuant to General Assembly resolution 70/1, the Secretary-General, in cooperation with the United Nations system, has the homour to submit the report on progress towards the Sustainable Development Goals. The present report is the first annual report on the topic and provides a global overview of the current situation regarding the Sustainable Development Goals, on the basis of the latest available data for indicators in the proposed global framework. The report also highlights the theme of the 2016 session of the high-level political forum on sustainable development, canwend under the asspices of the Economic and Social Council, "linearing that no one is left behind", through examples of disaggregated data that pinpoint where specific population groups are lagging behind. Finally, the report provides information on the methodologies used for the compilation of global indicators as well as an overview of data mailability and statistical challenges.








Goal 1: End poverty in all its forms everywhere

In signing Agenda 2030, governments around the world committed to ending poverty in all its manifestations, including its most extreme forms, over the next 15 years. They resolved that all people, everywhere, should enjoy a basic standard of living. This includes social protection benefits for the poor and most vulnerable and ensuring that people harmed by conflict and natural hazards receive adequate support, including access to basic services.

Poverty was halved over a decade, but one in eight people around the world still lived in extreme poverty in 2012.

The international powerty line is currently defined as \$1.90 per person per day using 2011 portnasing power perits; in the docade from 2002 to 2012, the proportion of the global population fixing below the powerty line dropped by half, from 20 to 13 per cent. If economic growth rates observed during those 10 years prevail for the next 15, the global rate for extreme powerty will likely fall to 4 per cent by 20081, assuming that growth benefits all income groups equally. Powerty remarks widespread in sub-Saharan Africa, where more than 40 per cent of people lived on less than \$1.90 a day in 2012.



Different roles in the global SDG reporting

- National statistical systems: collect data according to the Fundamental Principles of Official Statistics and provide data and metadata for global reporting.
- Regional mechanisms (regional offices of IOs, regional statistical systems such as Eurostat, SD of RCs, etc.): may facilitate, as appropriate, the data and metadata transmission process from the national to the global level and/or compile data from countries (Eurostat)
- International agencies: Provide internationally comparable data in the different statistical domains, calculate global and regional aggregates, and provide data and accompanying metadata to UNSD.
- UNSD: produce the global SDG reports and make available the internationally comparable country data on each of the indicators and the regional and global aggregates in the SDG Indicator global database. This increases transparency and allows data users, including the Member States, to easily access all data on the SDGs in one single place, together with the respective metadata.
