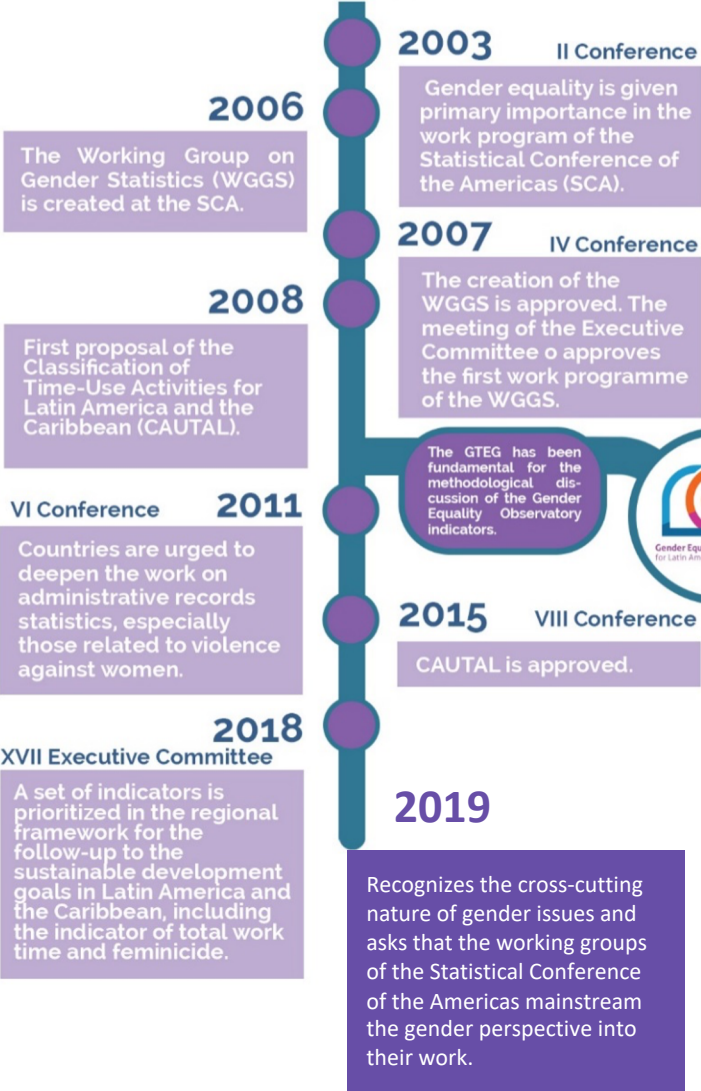

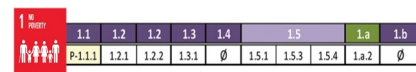

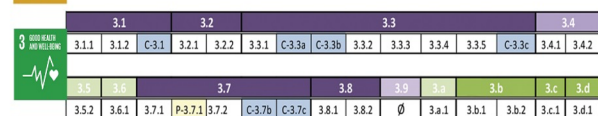

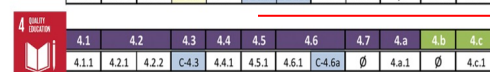

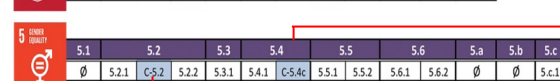
Proportion of population without own income, by sex



Percentage of live births to adolescent and young mothers that were unplanned



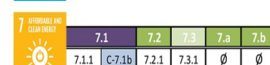
Average hours per week spent on unpaid and paid work by sex



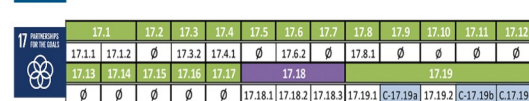
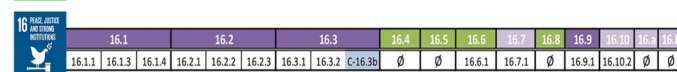
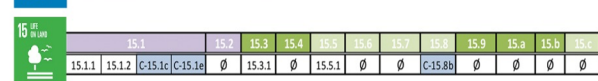
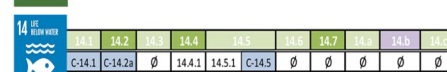
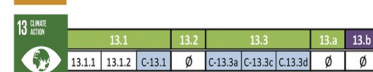
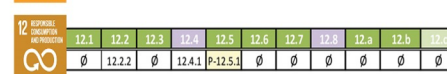
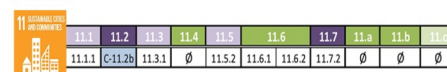
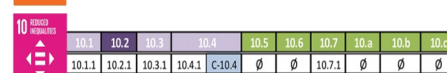
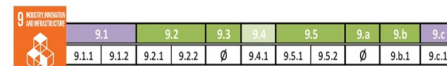
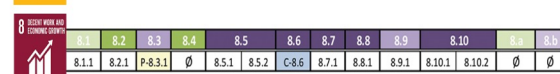
Rates of femicide
